Nursery will be closed on Monday 18th March for the St Patrick's Day Bank Holiday.

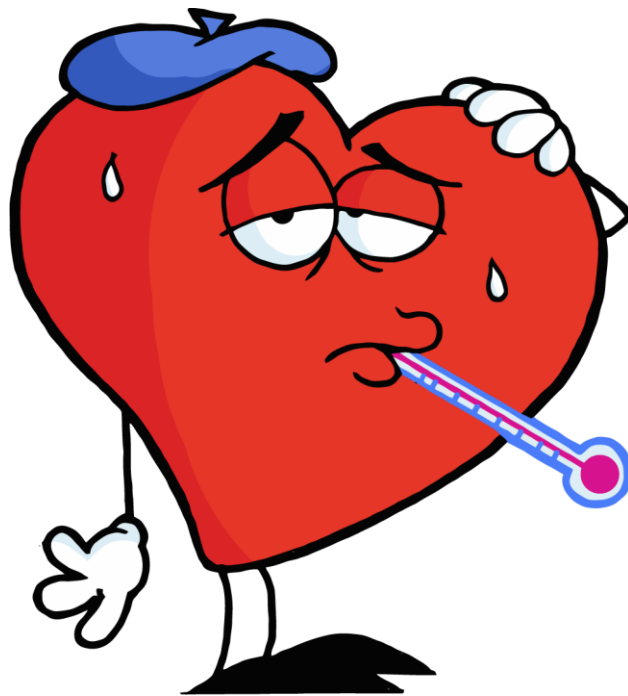
We will be having our Happy Healthy Kids evening on Thursday 14th March. This event will run from 6:30pm - 7:30pm. More details will follow.

Please send in a box of tissues. With all the colds that have been going around our supply has depleted.

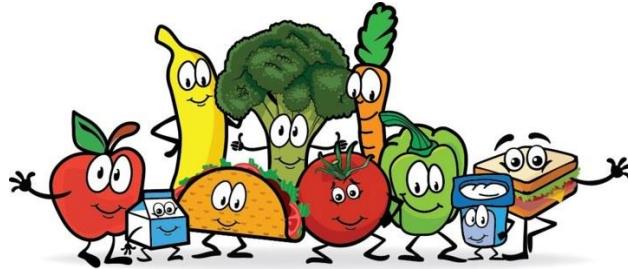
School closes for the Easter Break on Monday 25th March at 11:30am. **No dinners will be served.**

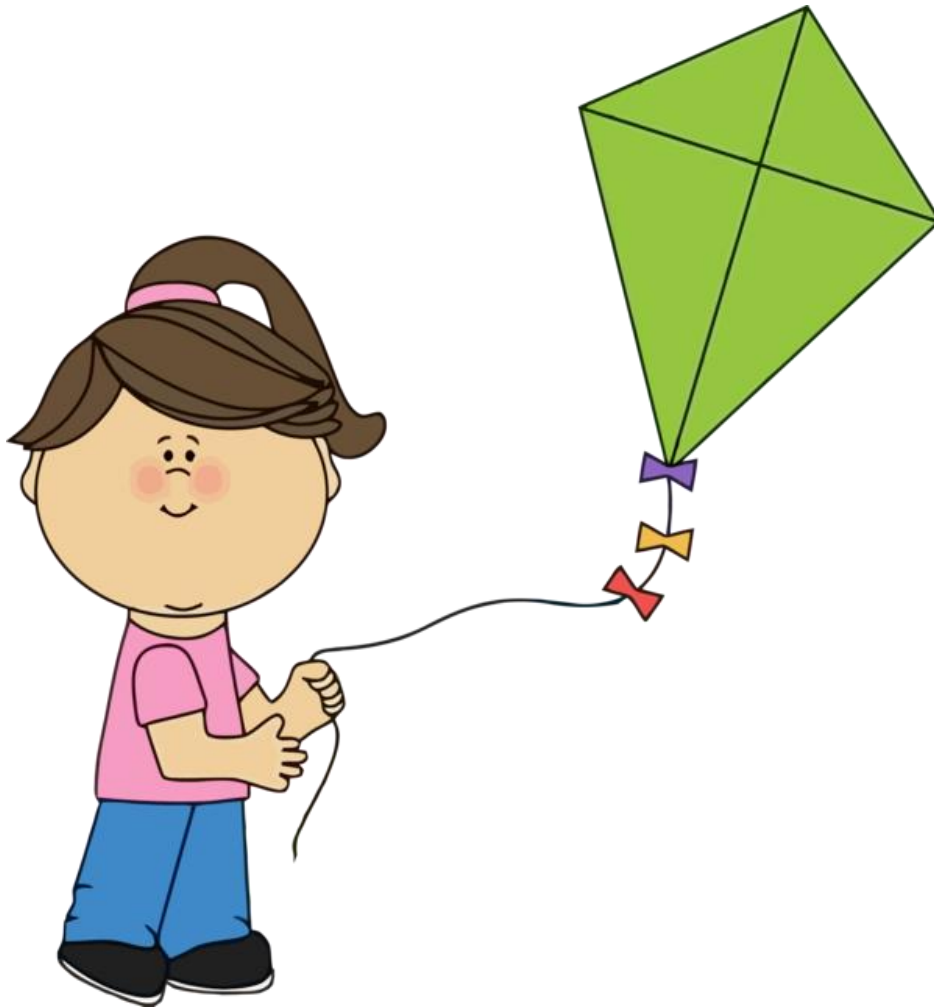

- **Monday 8th April** - school reopens for Summer term.

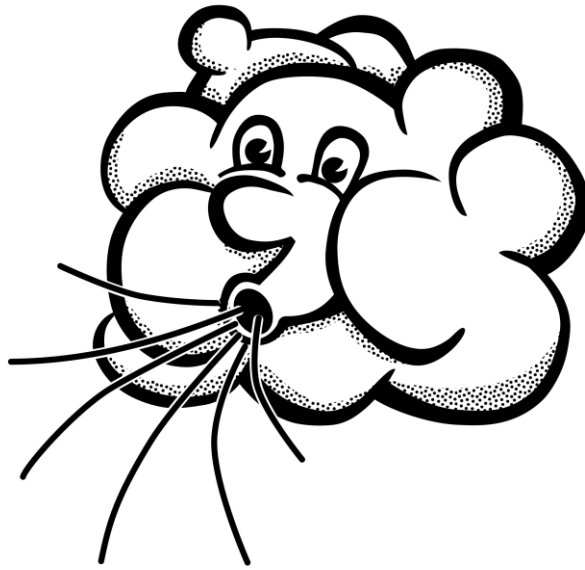
Happy Healthy Kids Go Fly a Kite
